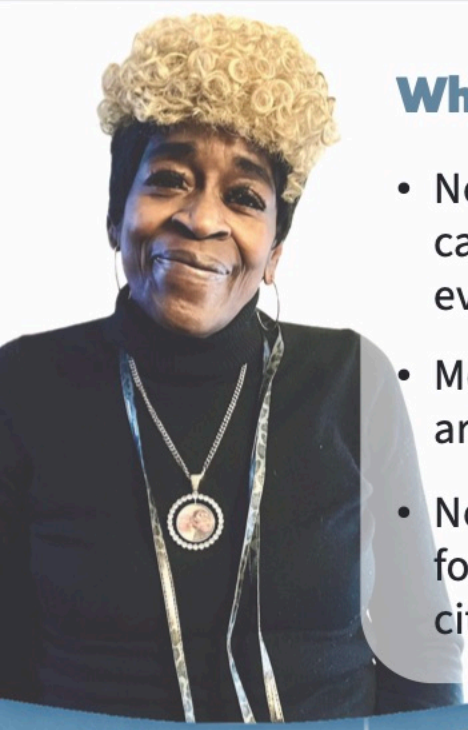

Why Our Neighbors Need Help

- Nearly 40% of tri-county households cannot afford the basic cost of living, even those who are working.
- More than 600 local school children are currently homeless.
- North Charleston ranks #1 nationally for eviction filings among large U.S. cities.

Many working-poor families in the Charleston Tri-County Area are barely hanging on. Single parents with low-paying jobs lack savings or safety nets, leaving them only a setback away from utility disconnection and eviction.

We aim to assist, not to carry.

Dove Fund carefully selects clients who are willing and ready to do their part. Because we limit ourselves to 3-5 families at a time, every household gets individual attention, an action plan, and a nurturing relationship. We do not receive government funding -- every dollar comes from private donors and local grants.

Typical services include preventing evictions, stopping utility shutoffs, funding move-in deposits, and connecting families to partner charities for furniture, financial literacy, and job training.

Struck by a hit-and-run driver and left unconscious, Katie leaned on Dove Fund while she healed and trained for a new career.
